3. Brief Updates from clubs

Hetton: Lots of new swimmers joining, senior swimmers have left for University. Encouraging swimmers to be competitive and enter competitions. Christmas party night planned for a couple of week time, trying to increase the community aspect of the club. Losing officials.

South Tyneside: Attended the shrimp gala in October. A lot of swimmers have left as a result of Covid, a lot of the squads are inexperienced at competitions. Interest in the beginner side of the club. Will be closing the club over Christmas. AGM planned for the next couple of weeks, all committee members are looking to be replaced, no one has come forward to fill the roles. JR – suggested looking outside the club for volunteers, contact VODA

Gateshead Whickham: Club have attended a number of galas over the next couple of months, have own gala planned for 18th Dec. Have a number of new officials coming through training. Had AGM in November which was well attended. Restructured the coaches within the club. Have a lead performance coach instead of a head coach, looking at developing the bottom end of the club with the previous head coach.

Tynemouth: Gala was stopped on the weekend due to the storm, seeing if they can re-run the competition. Swimmers have been going to a lot of competitions. Struggling with

coaches and teachers. Have a waiting list but don't have the teachers to run the sessions. Have someone interested in attending a coaching course but struggling to get places on a course. Stevie to speak to Jacqueline about the coaching programme within the club.

Gateshead Synchro – Update provide via email: *Gateshead Synchro are doing well, we have more or less made up for lost pool time pre COVID. Although we don't have the same amount of land sessions as the club is now bigger and it would be impracticable to have all swimmers in the studio at once. Being bigger is a great position for us to be in though so we are not complaining.*

Unfortunately all of our competitions have been virtual and Swim England decided each swimmer could only enter one of three national competitions. Which has caused a logistical nightmare as we are a comparatively small club and competitive swimmers had to choose between competitions and as a result our teams are at their lowest limit for size and therefore vulnerable to COVID absences. North East have not done any competitions, they had one virtual land one earlier in the year.

We are noticing the impact of COVID absence at the moment. We would also appreciate any guidance on returning to training post COVID. We have a few swimmers struggling and I think coaches feel vulnerable. I could find one for returning to swimming as a non athlete but if anyone has anything for athletes that would be very helpful.

We have two swimmers on the DiSE at the moment one in year 1 and one in year 2.
