An enthusiasm to advance swimming throughout the club would be encouraged. It would be expected that the Head Coach would attend most galas.

- Plan the competition calendar and ensure support and attendance of all swimmers
- Plan and follow through, in consultation with coaching staff tailored training programmes across all swim squads in line with LTAD
- Organise regular swimming coaching team meetings to discuss swimmer progress
- Supervise the coaching rota
- Follow the Swim England's Wavepower policies concerning the safeguarding and welfare of children.
- Comply with all Club policies
- Attend relevant training courses and meetings
- Give updates to monthly Committee Meetings
- Ensure positive relationships with all swimmers, parents, coaches and volunteers
